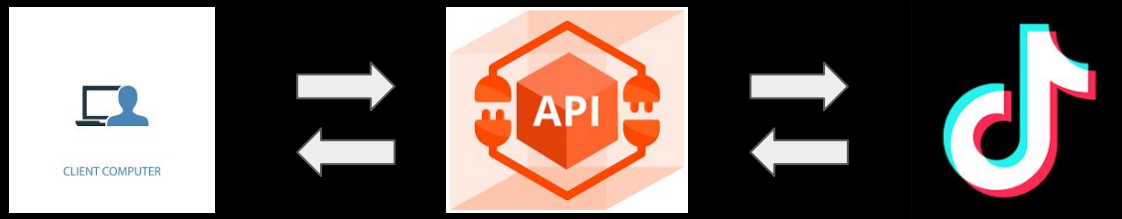

What is an API?

- **API = Application Programming Interface**
 - A software intermediary that allows to applications to talk to each other

Documented APIs

- Documented APIs = free/paid APIs that organizations want 3rd-parties to use
 - TikTok Research API
 - OpenAI API
 - Jigsaw Toxicity API
 - Google Ads API

Undocumented APIs

- Undocumented APIs = “unsung heroes making sure websites run”
 - Infinite scroll to load more posts → [instaloader](#)
 - Autocomplete suggestions → [suggests](#)
 - Obscured labels → [Amazon Brand Detector](#)

Why Undocumented APIs are Useful

- Example: [Markup's investigation of YouTube's hidden advertiser keyword blocklist](#)
 - Explored keyword search tool for YouTube advertisers and found evidence of a hidden keyword blocklist
 - Found undocumented API that was powering the hidden keyword blocklist
 - Demonstrated pattern of YT blocking racial justice terms, but allowing hate terms
